# SOLAR COMMITTEE RECOMMENDATIONS RECAP

Drozdziel and Tonra had presented the Solar Committee's recommendations to the Village Board June 19. The chairman invited Tonra to recap that presentation.

To begin with, the committee had recommended allowing the accessory use of solar energy systems in the Village. Tier 1 systems could have a capacity of up to 25 kilowatts and generate no more than 110 percent of the electricity consumed onsite.

So, how had the committee come up with the 110 percent figure?

That was the maximum allowed by the state, Tonra explained, adding it wasn't a random figure but rather an "industry standard." Tier 1 systems included: roof, ground and building-mounted systems as well as building integrated systems.
